Q̓w̓alayu House virtual art show FAQs

Q. How many pieces of artwork per young artist?

A. Young artists can submit a maximum of three pieces.

Q. What is the submission deadline?

A. All artwork must be received by March 26, 2021.

Q. What if we want to create artwork for more than one theme?

A. You are welcome to create artwork for three different themes. The selected artwork will be displayed in the corresponding themed room, so please keep artwork to one theme per piece.

Q. When will Q̓w̓alayu House entries be selected? How will artists be notified?

A. Once the show closes, it will take up to four weeks to review all submissions and make a final decision. Artists whose artwork is selected for Q̓w̓alayu House will be notified via phone and/or email.

Q. What is my artwork being used for?

Your artwork will be displayed in a digital art show on www.islandkidsfirst.com. If your artwork is selected for Q̓w̓alayu House, it will be framed and placed in the room corresponding to the theme of your art piece for families and children to enjoy during their stay at Q̓w̓alayu House. Below your artwork will be your first name, age, and title of your piece.

Q. How many pieces of artwork will be selected?

A. At least two pieces of artwork will be selected for each theme.

Q. Who is eligible to participate in this art show?

A. All amateur young artists aged 6 - 18 who live on Vancouver Island or the surrounding islands.

Q. What can I use to create my artwork?

A. Markers, paints, watercolors, pastels, collage – as long as it is two-dimensional. All artwork must be submitted on 8.5" x 11" paper to allow for framing and displaying on a wall.

Q. Can I send in my artwork digitally?

A. No, unfortunately only mailed-in artwork will be accepted.

Q. If my artwork isn't selected, will I receive it back?

A. No, unfortunately artwork will not be returned.

Q. I would like to submit a piece of artwork, but I cannot print the entry form. Can I still take part?

A. Yes, absolutely. Please handwrite the information required on a separate piece of paper and include it along with your submission.
