How to create your individual fundraising webpage

- 1. Go to www.justgiving.com/campaign/whenpigsfly2024
- 2. Click on the 'Start Fundraising' button.
- 3. Sign up for a JustGiving fundraising account and add your first name, last name, email, and create a password.
- 4. Complete your profile by filling in your address information.
- 5. Choose a type of fundraiser, or select the "Doing your own thing" option for general fundraising.



- 6. Share details about your activity including the type of activity, activity details, and date of activity (optional).
- 7. Set a goal for how much you would like to raise. Ensure the currency type is set to Canadian dollars (CAD).
- 8. Personalize your page:
 - a. Page title keep this short and sweet. This will be what people see when they land on your fundraising page, or when you share it on social media.
 - b. Why are you raising money tell your story. Share why you are raising money, how you are doing it, and what inspired you to fundraise.
 - c. Customize your web URL.
- 9. Upload a photo to your fundraising page.

How to create a team from your fundraising page

Team pages allow you and your friends/family/colleagues to join your individual fundraising pages together to contribute to an overall total. They're great if you want to raise money separately while still contributing to a larger team goal. The page will list each individual page and the collective total you've raised together.

- 1. Create a fundraising page following the process described on page 3 of this document.
- 2. On your page click the link called 'create a team.'
- 3. Give your team a name.
- 4. You'll be asked to confirm that you are fundraising for the WHEN PIGS FLY Radiothon.
- 5. Provide the story behind your reason to fundraise together and add a cover photo.
- 6. Set the team's fundraising targets:
 - a. You can set targets for individual team members by using the drop-down
- 7. Choose your team's web address and click on 'create a team.'
- 8. Invite your friends to join your team.

How to manage who's on my team?

- 1. Click on the member's tab at the top of your team page.
- 2. From here you can make your team page:
 - a. open for anyone to join OR by invitation only.
 - b. Invite or remove team members.

Prefer to fundraise as a group on the same page?

If you and your teammates would prefer to use the same page, create a regular fundraising page and list all of your names in the story section. Choose a web address that reflects your team name. You could also update the name in the account to reflect your team name.
